Children have been enjoying the warm weather by spending time outdoors, and in the local parks.

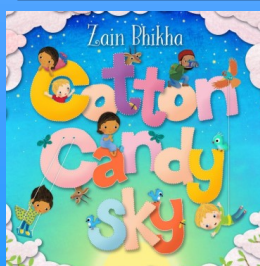
Please ensure that children come to school with a sun hat and please apply sun cream from home.

Mums and children were invited to our Nursery to spend sometime and play.

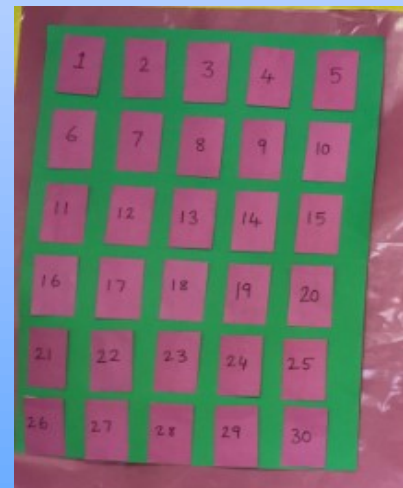
We had a great turn out and look forward to holding future sessions with the Mums and children.
